17 March 2013 - TEO in Gosport Ride

Start: Guildhall square at 10am. Route: mostly cycle paths and quiet roads Description: across to Gosport via the ferry to follow the route to Alverstoke to see the Crescent and the Crescent Gardens which were designed by Thomas Ellis Owen (TEO) in the 1820s. TEO designed much of Southsea Garden Suburb.
